**Thursday, 10 October** will see Masters Games archery come to Lobethal.

From 9.30 am, archers from around Australia (and possibly overseas) will gather to compete in friendly rivalry for the Unmarked Field Archery Event at the Lobethal Recreation Grounds and Bundara Reserve.

In this event, archers will be presented with 24 targets of varying sizes and set at distances dependent on the size of the target. Archers will be expected to estimate the distance. Three arrows per target are shot by each archer, for a total of 72 arrows.

The Australian Masters Games archery events are open to archers 30 years of age and older.

The Club now has Gift Vouchers available which will entitle the recipient to attend one of our 3-week beginners' coaching courses.



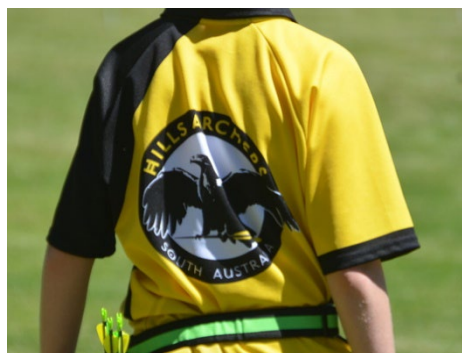
The voucher can be redeemed to enrol at a coaching course within a 12-month period, from the date of issue.

Toby W, as HILLS ARCHERS' sole representative at the ARCHERY SA State Field Championships at Strathalbyn, has taken out 1st place (Cub Male Compound) in style.

A score of **404** (from a possible 432) topped the previous record of 389, shot in June this year by Josh T of Eden.

Toby ended up with an average score per arrow of 5.61 (out of 6) with only three arrows out of the gold for the whole day.
