## Restrictions Update - from 15 April, 2022

**15 March:** The requirement for masks (indoors) and the QR Code check-in at Lenswood is lifted. Of course, if you wish to continue to use a mask, that is entirely up to you. If you are unwell, please think of others and consider deferring your visit until you are symptom-free.

**12 March:** Restrictions have been lifted. Sports are still required to use the QR Code check-in. Density limits have been removed. If we hold a meeting (for example) indoors, masks are required.

**29 January:** There is **no change** for sporting Clubs.... the same provisions apply, as previously advised (27 December).

### **COVID-19 Restrictions announced 4 August**

**2 August:** From Thursday, 5 August, sport can return to competition and coaching, but for all indoor areas, mask wearing is required. All spectators at outdoors sports are required to wear masks.

**27 July:** Sport will resume with practice only (so there can be no scoring or coaching), until Sunday, 8 August. It is unclear whether this includes the Sunday, but as information comes to hand, this page will be updated.

**20 June:** Level 5 Restrictions (Stay at Home Orders) apply from 6.00 pm, Tuesday, 20 July for 7 days.

**19 June:** Clarification has been published about the impacts for sport.

The Level 4 requirements restrict: ...

#### **Fitness or recreation activities:**

- **Indoor facilities closed**
- **No team, club or competitive sport**
